Manildra Group extends our gratitude to local residents for your patience, understanding, and cooperation during this time. We value our relationship with the local community and appreciate your continued support.

On Thursday 17th October 2024 at approximately 10pm very significant damage was suffered to grain silos at the Shoalhaven Starches site, spilling wheat grain (food grade) onto the surrounding area and into the Shoalhaven River.

To ensure a coordinated and effective response, Manildra Group is working with authorities and regulatory bodies, including SafeWork NSW, the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure, and the NSW Environment Protection Authority.

While the demolition of the damaged silos is complete, cleanup operations are still underway and require round-the-clock efforts. We value the wellbeing of the local community and recognise the potential impact of these activities.
